

## ANNUAL DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020

to be held on Saturday and Sunday, 7th and 8th March 2020

<u>Times</u>: Matches from - 12.00 midday on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March - 8.00am on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March

**<u>Eligibility to Compete</u>**: For Nepean District players. Specifically, a player must:

- have played in at least three (3) matches in a Nepean competition in 2019 or 2020, or
- have taken part in a Nepean coaching/training program for at least one term in 2019 or 2020, or
- be a current Association Member, at the closing date for entries.

<u>Events</u>: Men's Singles and Doubles, Women's Singles and Doubles, and Mixed Doubles, in these grades: Open, A1, A2-3, B1-2, C (alternatively, Open, Special, B, C)

Number of events: A player may enter up to three (3) events only.

**Format**: Open\_events: all singles matches best of 3 tie-break sets (tie-break at 6-all). All doubles matches will be, best of 2 tie-break sets, with a (10-point) match tie-break if one set-all. <u>Grade events</u>: round robin format, as determined by the numbers of entries <a href="Entry fees">Entry fees</a>: Singles - \$20.00 each; Doubles - \$30 per pair (all entry fees must be paid before playing first match)

- Matches will be played at the Woodriff Gardens Tennis Centre (Penrith).
